

## eMarine Website Access

The eMarine website provides a "secure" environment in which information, resources, and support are available to Marines and their family members 24 hours a day, regardless of their geographic location. We will be able to post anything that we would email ... for example deployment information/updates that would be an OPSEC violation on any other site like Facebook. A Unit's eMarine site promotes a community feeling within the Marine Corps Units by providing a place that is customized to the Unit and contains content that is controlled by the Unit. eMarine is a Commander's tool that allows them to communicate directly to Marines and family members. Unit sites can be accessed any time to view information, photos, read stories, and more. The FRO is the only person who has full technical control of this site for the battalion.

To subscribe to our battalion's site as a Marine or Family Member, click on the **Find a Unit Site** button at the top of the page. Click on "**California**," and then look for "**Camp Pendleton**." Click on "**1st Marine Division > Headquarters Battalion (california, Community: MCB Camp Pendleton, UIC: M11015)**"

I have uploaded all the Marines in our Marine OnLine (MOL) database. Sailors must be entered manually per request if they are not in MOL. I will be updating our database every Friday which will add new members and remove members who PCS and EAS.

### Marines

You will need to log in as the "Sponsor." You will need to provide information about yourself including your name and your birthday in the MMDD format. If the data you enter matches with the data in the Unit's Sponsor Database, you will immediately become a subscriber and be granted access to the site.

### Family Members

You will need to log in as the "Family Member." You will enter your information and the information regarding your "Sponsor of Interest." Your sponsor is your Marine/Sailor. If the data you enter matches a Marine within the Unit Sponsor's Database (uploaded via MOL), and you are listed as a contact on the Marine's MOL Family Readiness Family Member List, you will be granted access to the site.

**\*\*YOU MUST BE IN YOUR MARINE/SAILOR'S MOL FAMILY READINESS MODULE TO BE GRANTED ACCESS TO EMARINE. YOUR MARINE/SAILOR IS THE ONLY ONE WHO CAN ADD YOU INTO HIS MOL ACCOUNT.\*\***

### **MOST COMMON LOG IN ISSUES:**

- Putting the Marine/Sailor's (aka Sponsor) last name in the first name box.
- Family Members logging in as sponsors
- Not putting in the Marine/Sailors correct name (all individuals with suffixes must add the suffix

ex. John Doe Jr)
- Sponsors with first names longer than 10 letters must only enter the first 10 letters (ex. Christopher must be entered as Christophe)
- 
- Do not enter any symbols (ex. O'Bryan should be entered as Obryan, John Doe, Jr. should be entered as John Doe Jr)
