

What To Do In Case of an Emergency



Compound	Quantity
POLS	42 gallons
JP-5, JP-8, Diescl	42 gallons
Gasoline	5 gallons
Paint	42 gallons
STB Bleach (Sub-Tropical Bleach)	1 gallon
DS-2	1 gallon
Sulfuric Acid	1 gallon
Unknown Chemical	Any amount
Compressed Gas	Any leak
Out-or-Control chemical reaction	Any size
Stray munitions that leave target	Any
Other known chemical	Any amount greater than CERCLA reportable quantities (Attachment 1 of the Core Plan).

Tier I

1. Contain spill
2. Clean up spill
3. Notify AC/S Env. Sec. Phone: (760)725-9768/9743 After business hours Phone: (760) 725-4321
4. Complete and fax form SRP-1 to AC/S Env. Sec. within 1 hour Fax # (760) 725-0207

1. Evacuate the area in a life-threatening situation.
2. Notify personnel in immediate area.
3. Isolate and deny entry (close doors and prevent people from entering)
4. Restrict ignition sources if safe to do so.
5. Call 911.

6. Provide the 911 dispatcher with the following information:
 - Description of the incident
 - Assistance requested
 - Location of incident
 - Number and extent of injuries (if applicable)
 - Name and quantity of hazardous materials involved (if applicable or known)
 - Your name and phone number
 - Do you have an MSDS for the chemical that spilled?
7. Remain on the line until 911 dispatcher releases you.
