Violence Prevention Policy Statement



The purpose of this policy is to ensure the safety of our Marines, Sailors, civilians, and families in accordance with Marine Corps Order 5580.3.

Violence prevention includes efforts to assess, investigate, mitigate, and respond to behaviors that may precede acts of harassment, intimidation, threats, violence, as well as behaviors consistent with radicalization and insider threats.

Acts of physical violence against persons or property, physical or verbal threats, intimidation, harassment, or other inappropriate, disruptive behavior that causes fear for personal safety on or off duty will not be tolerated. Do not ignore warning signs and indicators of potential violence—early identification and intervention can prevent a potential violent act. If you see or experience any of this behavior from anyone, report it immediately. All leaders who receive such reports will contact the Violence Prevention Officer (VPO) immediately to take appropriate action. Report threats that require immediate law enforcement involvement by calling 911 or the Provost Marshalls Office at 760-763-2075.

Violence prevention is everyone's responsibility.
